

## Is BOTOX®, a Dermal Filler procedure or Blepharoplasty (Lid Lift) right for you?

The best way to understand what you can expect from any of these procedures is to schedule a consultation with Dr. Mono who specializes in these procedures.

Dr. Jeffrey Mono is an oculoplastic surgeon, an ophthalmologist with a sub-specialty in reconstructive surgery of the eyes and face. As you research your physician options on these processes, we recommend that you ask any surgeon with whom you are consulting the following questions:

- What other options are available?
- Will I have to limit my activities after surgery, and for how long?
- What are the short-term benefits of the procedure?
- Are there any long-term benefits?
- What changes can I realistically expect after the procedure?
- Can you help me evaluate my prospects for the healing process and how long does it take?
- Is there any possibility that these procedures will adversely affect my vision?
- What, if any, are the side effects of these procedures?
- How long do these procedures typically last?

Be sure to discuss the cost of the procedure and follow-up care requirements with your doctor, as most aesthetic procedures are not covered by most health insurance policies. The Midwest Center for Sight charges a \$75.00 initial consultation fee with Dr. Mono and his technician. If you choose to proceed with the procedure immediately, the cost of the consultation is applied to the total cost of the procedure.
